5 girls in year 2 had an amazing afternoon at their dance school awards

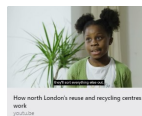

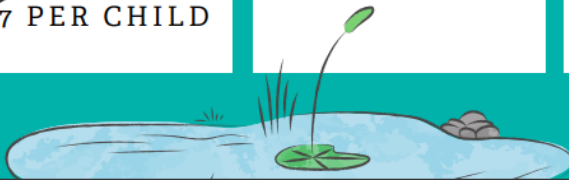

To save our planet is our goal,



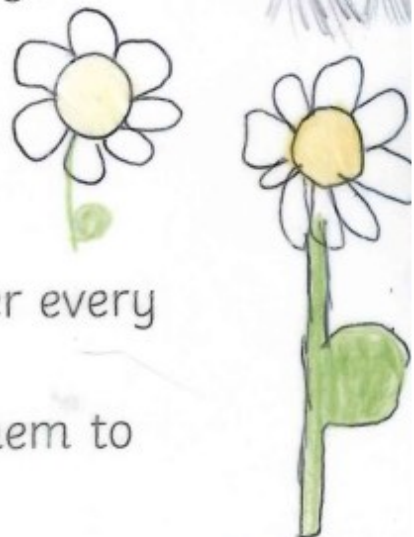
Attract more animals, butterflies and bees,
