**It is the Governors' Policy that all pupils should attend wearing our school uniform.**

<b>Optional Summer Uniform (for Summer Term only)</b>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Navy blue / white <b>checked</b> dress or navy-blue shorts</li> <li>White polo shirt with / without our school logo</li> </ul> <p>*No pale blue check or striped dresses</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Navy blue / white <b>checked</b> dress or navy-blue shorts</li> <li>White short sleeved shirt or blouse with our school tie – navy with pale blue and white stripes</li> </ul> <p>*No pale blue check or striped dresses</p>

<b>Footwear</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Smart, sensible shoes which your child can remove and put on themselves, preferably black or navy.</li> <li>Navy or white tights or socks for girls; navy or white socks for boys.</li> </ul> <p>*No heels, sandals, open toes or jellies; *boots should not be worn in school; *Trainers are not part of our school uniform.</p>

<b>P.E Dress Code</b>
<p>A bag containing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Navy shorts and white tee shirt with / without our school logo</li> <li>Navy joggers and navy sweatshirt with / without our school logo (for Winter)</li> <li>KS1 plimsolls or trainers with Velcro for outdoor P.E.</li> <li>KS2 trainers for outdoor P.E.</li> </ul>

<b>For Health and Safety Reasons, it is policy that:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Long hair is tied back, particularly for PE and Cooking; hair bands and accessories in school colours and of a sensible size</li> <li>No nail varnish is worn</li> <li>Jewellery should not be worn to school, except small stud earrings. Local Authority regulations state that <b>all jewellery must be removed for PE</b>, earrings must not be taped over and children must be able to remove earrings themselves.</li> <li>Watches may be worn by pupils from Year 2 upwards.</li> </ul>
