Kallie F and Kimberley D both completed yellow hat at swimming last week and have moved up to green hat.



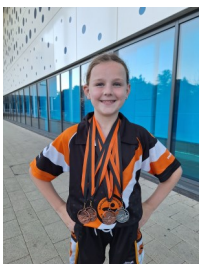
Jessica received the 'Coaches Player' award for her Flames netball Squad, Tornadoes, this year.

Madison L completed her swimming Level 7. She received her 200m and 400m badges and her bronze swimming challenge badge! She will be starting the summer in Level 8.

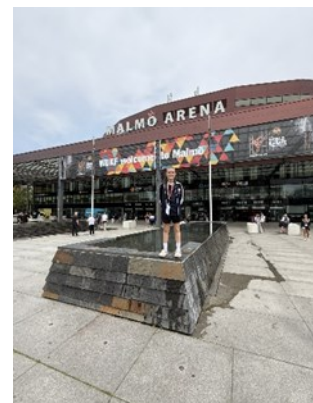
