Langdon Hills Nature Reserve – Wednesday 15th April 2026

As part of our science curriculum linked to plants and animals and their habitats, we will be taking the year 2 children to Langdon Hills Nature Reserve. The trip will take place on Wednesday 15th April 2026. Children need to come into school at normal time; doors will open at 8.35am and close promptly at 8.45am. We will be departing soon after. We will be back before the end of the school day, and children can be collected at 3.15pm from our pod door.

The children will be taking part in different workshops including 'Plant Power' and 'Living Things and their Habitats'.

Children must wear school uniform for this trip, including sensible footwear. They will need a waterproof/warm coat. Children will also need a packed lunch (no sweets, chocolate or nuts) and a water bottle in a small, named rucksack.

In order to facilitate this visit, we will require a payment of £18.00 to cover the cost of the coach and the entrance fee. If insufficient money is contributed to cover the cost of the visit, the school will have to consider cancelling the trip. Please note that all educational visits are non-profit making.

Payments for this visit have been set up on Bromcom 'MCAS' app under Trips. This will be open for you to pay from 7pm on 08/01/2026 until 9am on 01/04/2026 We will not be accepting cash or cheques for this visit.
