Science of Sound workshop: Wednesday 20th May 2026

As part of our science curriculum linked to sound and vibrations, the year 4 children will be taking part in a workshop to explore how sound is made. The workshop will take place on Wednesday 20th May 2026 and will be held within our school day.

Children will be looking at key concepts of sound, such as volume and pitch, as well as investigating how sound was reproduced historically through the demonstration of a vintage wind-up phonograph. The day will consist of a range of activities, led by experts.
