## **Year 6 Safety and Personal Responsibility Workshops**

Dear Parents and Carers,

After the half-term break, Year 6 pupils will be taking part in a series of workshops and assemblies focused on safety and personal responsibility. These sessions are designed to support pupils as they prepare for the transition to secondary school.

The programmes will include:

- Crucial Crew – Wednesday 25th February
- Cyber Safety – Thursday 26th February
- Respect – Wednesday 4th March

The Crucial Crew Roadshow will be delivered by Safer Partnership Basildon and will involve age-appropriate talks covering important community safety messages. Topics will include vaping, knife crime and gangs. The sessions are interactive and aim to support children in developing informed decision-making skills and making positive life choices.

The Cyber Safety Workshop will be delivered by an Essex Fire and Rescue Service education officer and will focus on understanding online risks, recognising online scams and learning how to keep personal information safe.

The Respect Assembly, also delivered by an Essex Fire and Rescue Service education officer, will help children understand anti-social behaviour, the impact of words and actions on others, and the importance of treating everyone with respect.

We wanted to make you aware of these programmes so that if your child talks about any of these topics at home, you can be reassured that they have been explored in a safe, supportive and age-appropriate environment.
