Thurs 26 <sup>th</sup> February	Greek Workshop	<b>Children are invited to dress in Ancient Greek clothing.</b>
Mon 2 <sup>nd</sup> March	Road Safety Workshop	<b>All in school. Nothing required.</b> Children will be going out of school in small groups with a member of Essex Highways and a member of staff from school. They will be learning about road safety and practising how to cross roads around the school.

Wed 11 <sup>th</sup> March	Bridge Building Day	<b>In school activity. Nothing required.</b> Parents from Class 11 are invited in to help the class build bridges (see previous correspondence if you would like to sign up.)
Thurs 12 <sup>th</sup> March	Bridge Building Day	<b>In school activity. Nothing required.</b> Parents from Class 12 are invited in to help the class build bridges (see previous correspondence if you would like to sign up.)
Wed 18 <sup>th</sup> March	School trip to First Site Art Gallery	<b>The children will need to be in school at 8am promptly ready to depart from school by 8.15am</b> and will leave the art gallery at 2.30pm to <b>return to school at 3.30pm (traffic permitting).</b> Children must wear school uniform for this trip, including sensible footwear. They will need a coat. Children will also need a packed lunch (no sweets, chocolate or nuts) and a water bottle in a small, named rucksack. No spending money is needed.
