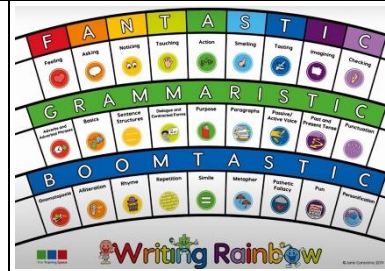
Termly Learning for Summer 1 (2025-2026)

We will be learning about the life cycle of plants. We will be learning about what seeds need to grow and germination.	Throughout the term we will be learning about 'What is a Monarch?'
