It has been a busy week with statutory assessments happening in key stage 1 and year 4. Well done to our key stage one children who have completed their phonics screening check this week. The children approached the task with composure and excitement. We have also completed our year 4 multiplication checks this week. Well done to year 4 who have completed these assessments.

On Wednesday, our EYFS children went to Barleylands. The children learnt about different types of food and where they come from. They got to make their own pizzas and choose the toppings. Throughout the day, the children saw some amazing hawks and owls as well as sevals, wallabees and tortoises. The children got to experience a tractor ride, which they loved. It was very bumpy! The children got to feed some goats and sheep, met some of the young/ baby animals and ended the day with a go on the bouncy pillow.
